Oldham Care Organisation is responsible for delivering healthcare services at the Royal Oldham Hospital and within the community.

By attending the event you will have the opportunity to meet our teams and find out more about the roles we have to offer.

We are recruiting for a number of Healthcare Support Worker roles across Oldham Hospital and community services such as: General Medicine, Surgery, Maternity Services to name just a few.

We will be holding interviews on the day, so don't forget to bring a copy of your CV if you wish to be interviewed. You may be asked you to complete an online application and other recruitment forms after your interview and we will be on hand to provide support & guidance if needed.

Healthcare support worker roles require a level of Maths & English competency and as part of our recruitment process there will be a short functional skills tests for candidates who do not have evidence of prior learning e.g., GCSE certificates.

The test will identify whether any further support/training is required. Failing to meet the required level doesn't automatically exclude an individual from interview, it may be that 'on the job' training can be provided if successful at interview, but it will ensure that you are ready for the role or get access to the necessary support to develop these skills.

If you have evidence of prior learning bring your certificates with you on the day, if you don't and are offered a post you will be asked to provide copies as part of your pre-employment checks.

If you don't feel ready for work just yet, our colleagues from the Widening and Participation Team will be on-hand to discuss pre-employment programmes we have to offer, to help you prepare for a career in healthcare.

For anyone who meets the benchmark for one of our roles, conditional offers will be made a few days after the event to allow for clinical managers to match candidates to suitable vacancies. Anyone who it is felt isn't yet ready for a role with us will be referred to one of our partners to look at how to successfully prepare for a role in healthcare.
